



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Upper Solford Township in the County of Philadelphia and Province of Pennsylvania Containing Two Hundred and Forty Nine Acres of Land Strict Measure or Two hundred and Thirty four Acres and 145 Perches of Land Together with the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads. Being near the half Part of a Tract of 500 Acres, That was formerly Surveyed to Francis Ganderwit in Pursuance of a Warrant, Dated The 10th of the 4 Month Anno 1717, Which Said Tract was afterwards divided for William Walton and David Walton Now Resurveyed on the 5th March Anno 1774. By Virtue of a Warrant of Resurvey Dated on the 3^d March Last past For the Said William Walton. By Order of the Surveyor General.
