



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 for Samuel Harris on a Certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number One hundred and Eighty containing in Breadth East and West on Blackberry Street Sixty feet and in Length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet Bounded Southward by Blackberry Street Eastward by Lot Number One hundred and Seventy nine Northward by Barberry Alley and Westward by River Alley Returned into the Secretary's Office the 8th day of September 1774 for Jonas Weaver by Warrant dated the 05th Instant.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February 1833, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this fourteenth day of March 1907.
