



A Draught of a Lot of Ground Situate on the North side of Pitt Street between Juliana and Richard Streets in the Town of Bedford in the County of Bedford marked in a General Plan of said Town Number One hundred and Eighty five Containing in Breadth East and West on the North side of Pitt Street and throughout Sixty feet and in Length North and South back to the South side of the Raystown Branch of Juniata River about five hundred and Twenty feet. Bounded Southward by Pitt Street aforesaid Eastward by Lot Number One hundred and Eighty four Northward by the Raystown Branch aforesaid and Westward by Lot Number One hundred and Eighty Six. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 3^d day of October 1774. for George Woods Esqr. by Warrant dated the same Day.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February 1833, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this eighteenth day of March 1907.
