



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Upper Milford Township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania, Containing forty Seven Acres and Twenty nine Perches of Land, Together with the Usual Allowance at Six per Cent. for Roads Being Part of a Tract of One Hundred and fifty Acres and the Allowance. That was by Patent of the 6th April 1770. Granted unto Christopher Goodman, who Sold the above part thereof Unto Jacob Wetzel. And as the Description of the Lines was found erroneous. The above was Resurveyed By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Land Office dated the 15th November Anno-1770. By Order of John Lukens Esquire Surveyor General on the 17th December Anno-1770.
