



A Draught of a Tract of Land, Situate in Upper Solford Township in the County of Philadelphia and Province of Pennsylvania Containing, One Hundred and ninety Acres and 20 Perches of Land together with the usual Allowance at Six Per Cent for Roads. That was originally Surveyed by Nicholas Scull unto Michael Boots on the 18th February 1733. The Warrant for the same was afterwards taken out by John Linch, Dated on the 17th January Anno-1734. The Right to the same was afterwards Sold to Henry Wurman for whose Heirs the same was Resurveyed on the 24th February Anno 1768. By Order of the Surveyor General.
