



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3 day of July following for James Goudy of a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Eighty two containing in Breadth North and South fifty Seven feet Six Inches, and in length East and West Two hundred and thirty feet Bounded Westward by Broad Way Southward by Lot N° 83 Eastward by River Alley and Northward by Lot N° 81. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 9th day of June 1773 for John Weitzel by Warrant dated the 8th Instant.
