



A Draught of a Survey executed May 27<sup>th</sup> 1827 for Benjamin Dorlington administrator of the estate of Joseph Simpson deceased in pursuance of a Warrant in the name of Mathew Simpson dated November 3<sup>d</sup> 1785 N<sup>o</sup> 197 situate on the waters of Turtle Creek in Plum<sup>b</sup> Township containing seventy one acres four perches and allowances of Six pr<sup>et</sup> being part of a larger tract containing in all four hundred thirty seven acres one rood twenty eight perches & allowances of Six pr<sup>et</sup>.
