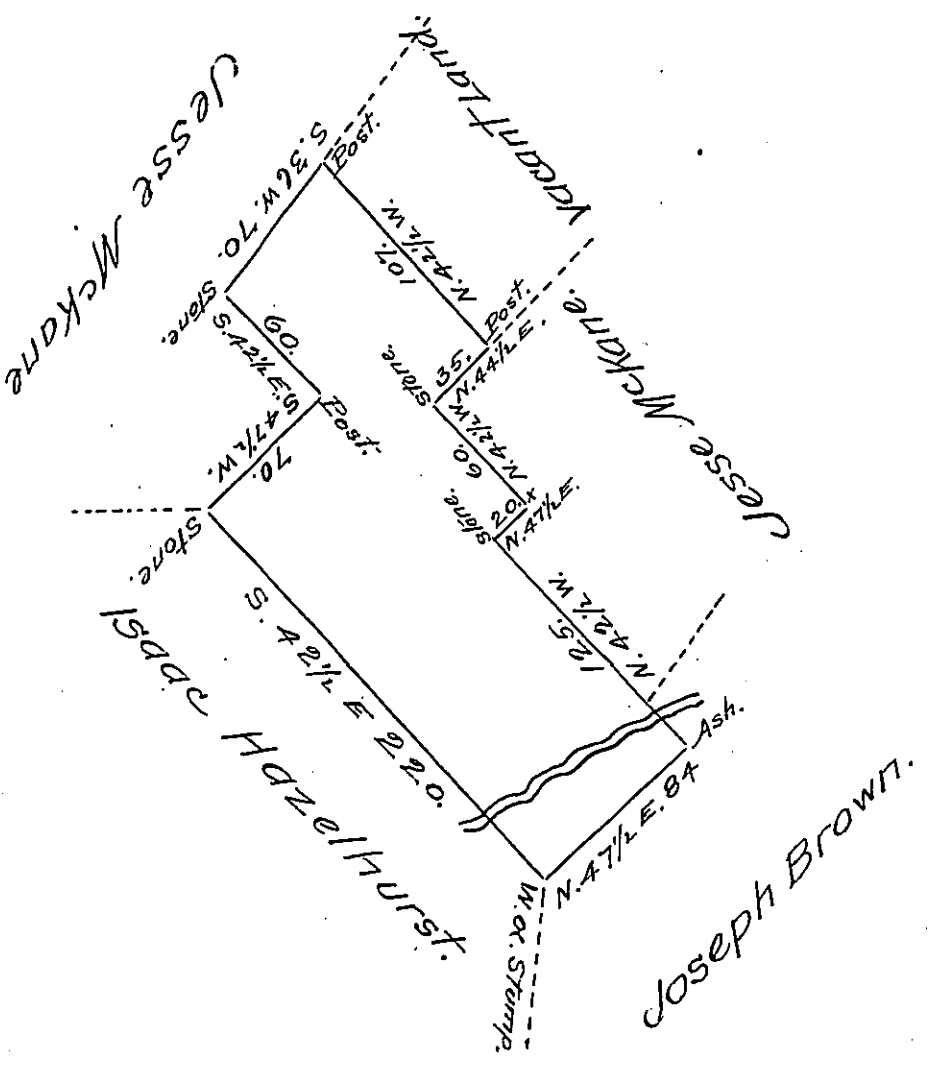


Dingman

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 12th day of October 1792 and order of survey recd. the 5th day of August 1846 Surveyed the 25th day of August 1846 to Abraham Shimer the above described Tract of land Situate (formerly in Upper Smithfield) now Dingman Township (formerly Northampton) now Pike County adjoining the old Wyoming road at a place called the Gum Swamp containing one hundred and fifty four acres twenty perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c
