



Situate in Frankestown Township Huntingdon County containing one hundred sixty three acres 141 perches & allowance the same being part of a tract of land originally surveyed the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of Oct. 1787 in pursuance of a warrant granted to James Smith dated 19<sup>th</sup> day of May 1787 the original survey was said to contain 175 acres 124 P<sup>s</sup> & allowance this part resurveyed & divided from the residue of said tract the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August 1834
