Sir

I surveyed the above described tract of land on a warrant granted by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to Archibald Stewart of North Sewekly Township and County of Beaver for two hundred acres of land dated the 8th day of September 1835 which I executed on the 25th of February 1836 on actual survey I find from the settled boundary as above represented to contain two hundred and twelve acres with the usual allowance of 6^{sq} ft for roads &c situate in said Township of North Sewekly in the County of Beaver on the North side of Conocrossing Creek adjoining lands as above stated with Philip Wager on the south, James Montgomery on the east Benjamin Chew on the north and William McQuiston on the west which have not heretofore been appropriated by this Commonwealth by warrant or other title or survey so far as I can learn from the books of surveys belonging to said County of Beaver given under my hand at South Beaver Township Beaver County the 27th day of February 1836
