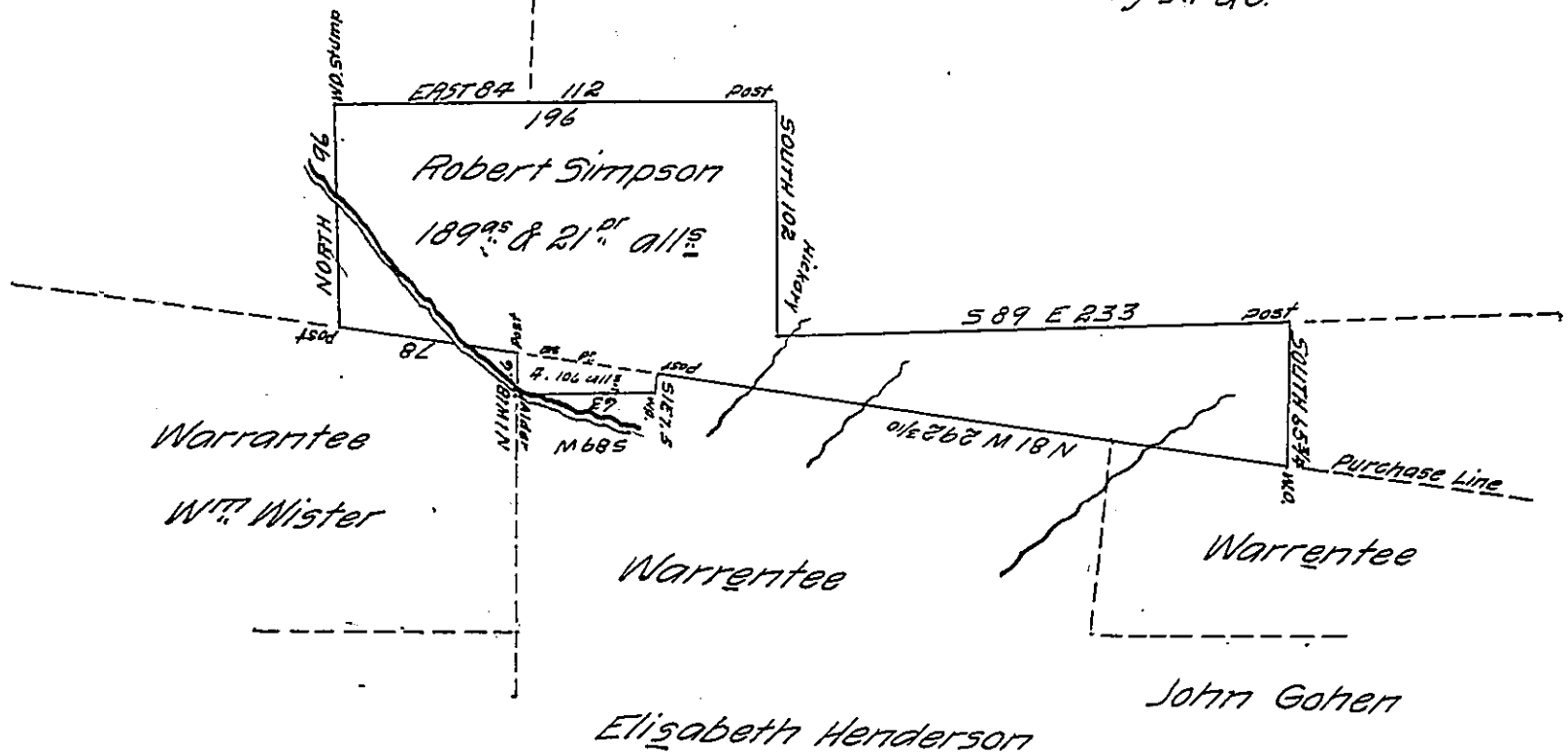

In pursuance of 2 warrants granted to Robert Simpson one dated the 21<sup>st</sup> Decr. 1832 and the other dated the 29<sup>th</sup> day of May 1834 the larger one in Wayne township the other in Plumcreek township were both surveyed on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of June 1834 each containing the amount there in represented situate - Armstrong County on the waters of Cowen'shannock
