



A draught of a tract of land called Springfield situate on the waters of Little Conemough — adjoining and west of land surveyed for Hugh Howell including a large spring adjoining also land of Stacey Hepburn and land granted to Samuel Pleasants in the County of Bedford containing three hundred & forty four acres and the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c surveyed the 25th day of March 1774 for John Wilson in pursuance of a warrant dated the 14th day of April in the same year
