

A draught of a tract of land called — situate on the east side of the north east branch of Susquehanna river and between the mouth of Wesaughking and Miname—in the County of Northumbers and adjoining and below land surveyed for Jacob Menard constaining three hundred and thirty acres besides the usual allowance of 6 P cent for roads & surveyed the 27th day of September 1773 in pursuance of an order to Benjamin Eshleman dated the 3th day of April 1769 Number 1480.
