In pursuance of a Warrant granted to Frederick Stover bearing date the 26th. day of January Anno Domini 1786. Divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 2d. day of April 1789, for Jacob Stover the present owner, who desired me to make Return of the Draught, as Calculated examined and corrected the 19th. day of August A.D. 1809.
