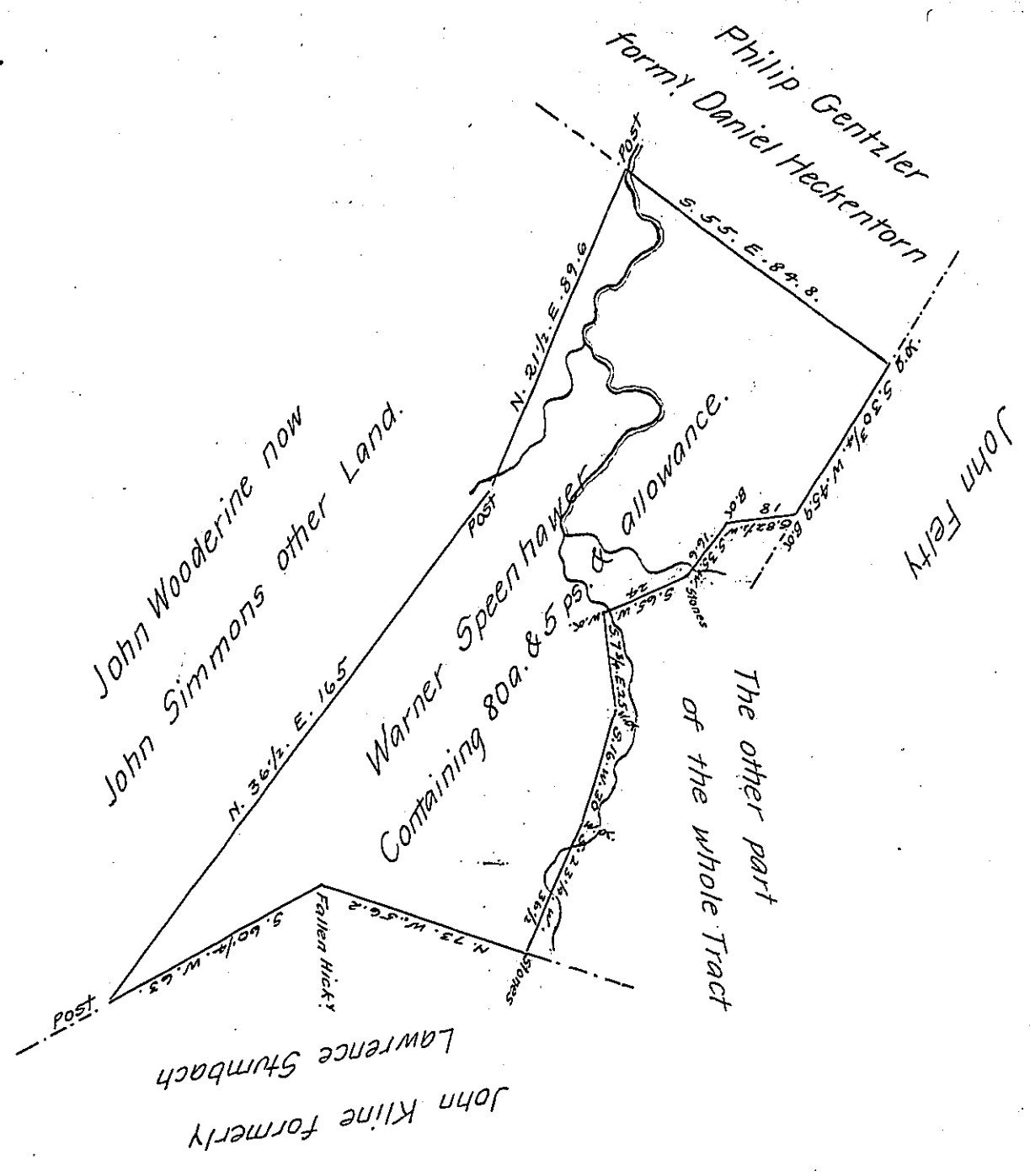



Granted to Warner Speenhawer, bearing date the 18th. day of December Anno Domini 1751. Resurveyed and Divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 23d. day of March Anno Domini 1809, at the instance and request of John Simmon the present owner who desired us to make Return of the Draught.
