



A Draught of a tract of Land in Greenfield township

Erie County on Lake Erie surveyed the 19th. day of October 1801 for William Wilson by Virtue of his Actual Settlement, and resurveyed the 23d. day of September 1802 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to the said William Wilson dated the 5th. of March 1802, Containing 400 acres and allowance. It being the same tract of Land which was said to have been surveyed on a Warrant dated the 13th. day of April 1792. Granted to Elias Boys on conditions of Actual Settlement and improvement Whereof Default hath occurred.
