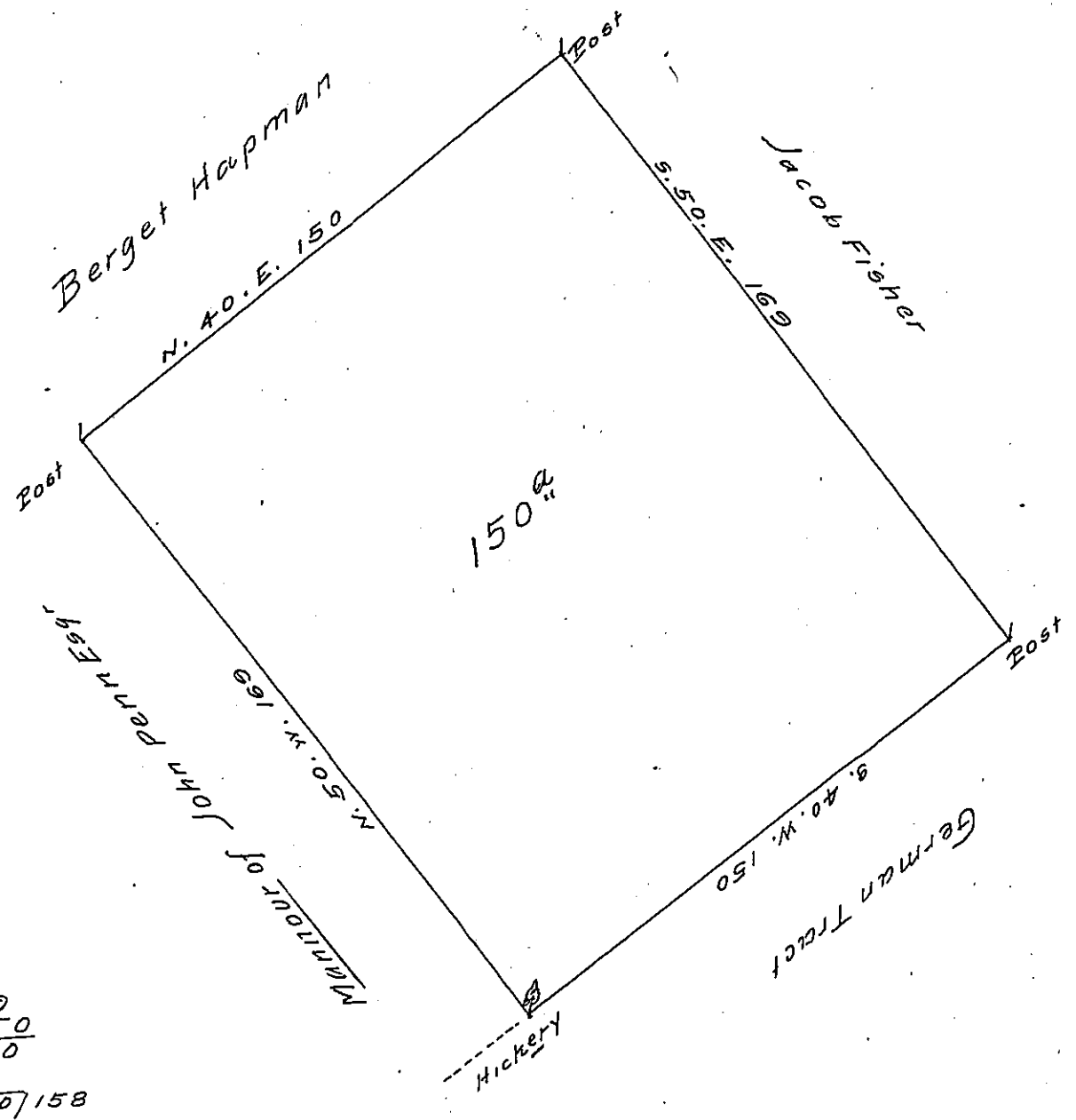

 East One hundred & Sixty nine perches to a post in the line of the German
 tract thence by the same South forty degrees West One hundred & fifty
 perches to the place of Begining. Containing One hundred & fifty
 acres with usual allowance
