



A Draught of Peter Wentz's Lands situate on the branches of Perki-  
 omy in the County of Bucks - One Tract contain<sup>g</sup> 100 acres & all-  
 owance of Six acres for Roads &c. first surveyed to Stephen Reamer  
 who sold to Peter Wentz.

Another Tract containing 89<sup>a</sup> 37<sup>per</sup> and Allow<sup>ance</sup> &c. another  
 containing 11<sup>a</sup> 23<sup>per</sup> and allowance &c. both surveyed to the 5<sup>d</sup> Peter  
 Wentz on the 10<sup>th</sup> of March 1738. By Vertue of a Warr<sup>t</sup> from the  
 Proprietaries dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of the same month.

Certified *J. D. Eastburn* Surv<sup>r</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup>  
 Stephen Reamer's Warrant dated 3<sup>d</sup> March 1734 and Ret-  
 urned for Patenting 3<sup>d</sup> December 1735.
