A Warrant was granted to David Meichter for about 100^a adjoining his other
Land (formerly surveyed to Ulrick Englehart) w^{ch} he purchased said
Warr^t was dated the 3^d of 9^{ber} 1736, sent for by D. Meichter at the req-
uest of Melchior Wegnar but D. M. took it out in his own name.

David Meichters Warr^t made void & another granted to Melchior
