



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries bearing date the 7 day of february Anno Dom: 1738. Surveyed the 23^d day of febr^y Anno Dom: 1738 to Robert Wallace a Tract of land situate in the Township of Hannover in the County of Lancast^s. Begining at a Blackwalnut standing by Swataror Creek side thence North 11^o Degrees West 110 p^{ces} to a Whight Oak thence North 79^o Degrees East 14 p^{ces} to a post thence North 11^o Degrees West 140 p^{ces} to a Black Oak thence South 50^o Degrees East 185 p^{ces} to a Beach standing by ye s^d Creek side thence down ye said Creek 298 p^{ces} to ye place of begining. Containing Two hundred acres and ye allowance of six p Cent for road and highways
