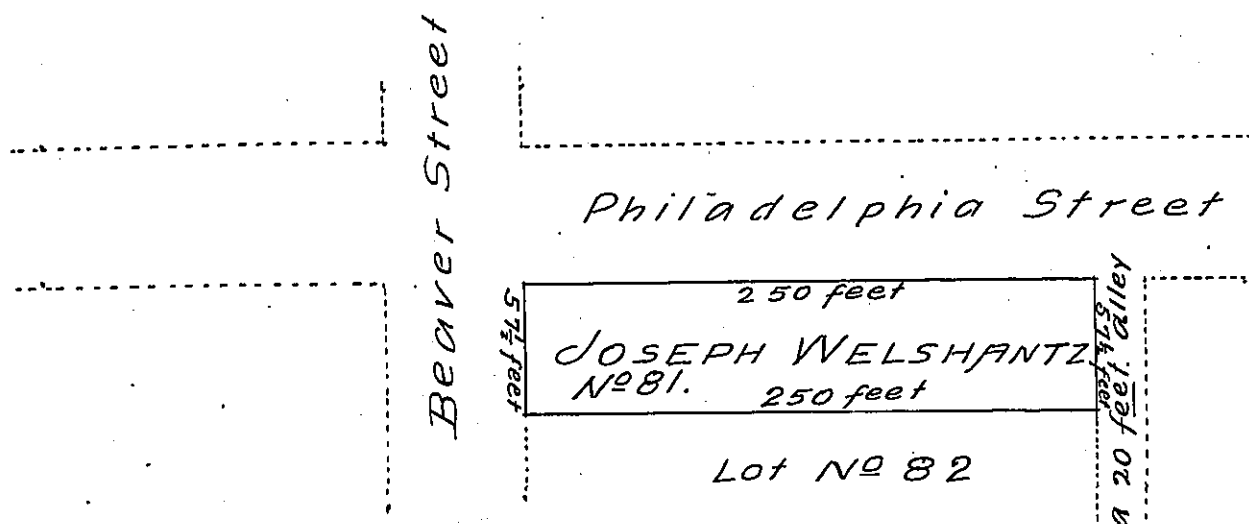


FORM NO. 1.



A Plan of a Lot of Ground Situate on the East Side of

 Street. Entered on the Plan of the said Town and Survey'd  
 for the said Joseph Welshantz who has built an House  
 on the same Lot according to the Conditions of settling  
 the Town, Certified at York the 1<sup>st</sup> June 1753
