



Situate in lower Mahanoy Township in the County of Northumberland on the waters of Mahanoy Containing one hundred and eight acres. Sixty four perches and allowance of Six Percent being part of a large tract of land. Surveyed unto Peter Troutman the first day of April 1791 by William Gray then D.S. in pursuance of his Warrant bearing date the 5<sup>th</sup> day of May 1790. Resurveyed 15<sup>th</sup> day of June 1827 Agreeably to old and well established lines, and corners as marked on the ground &c.
