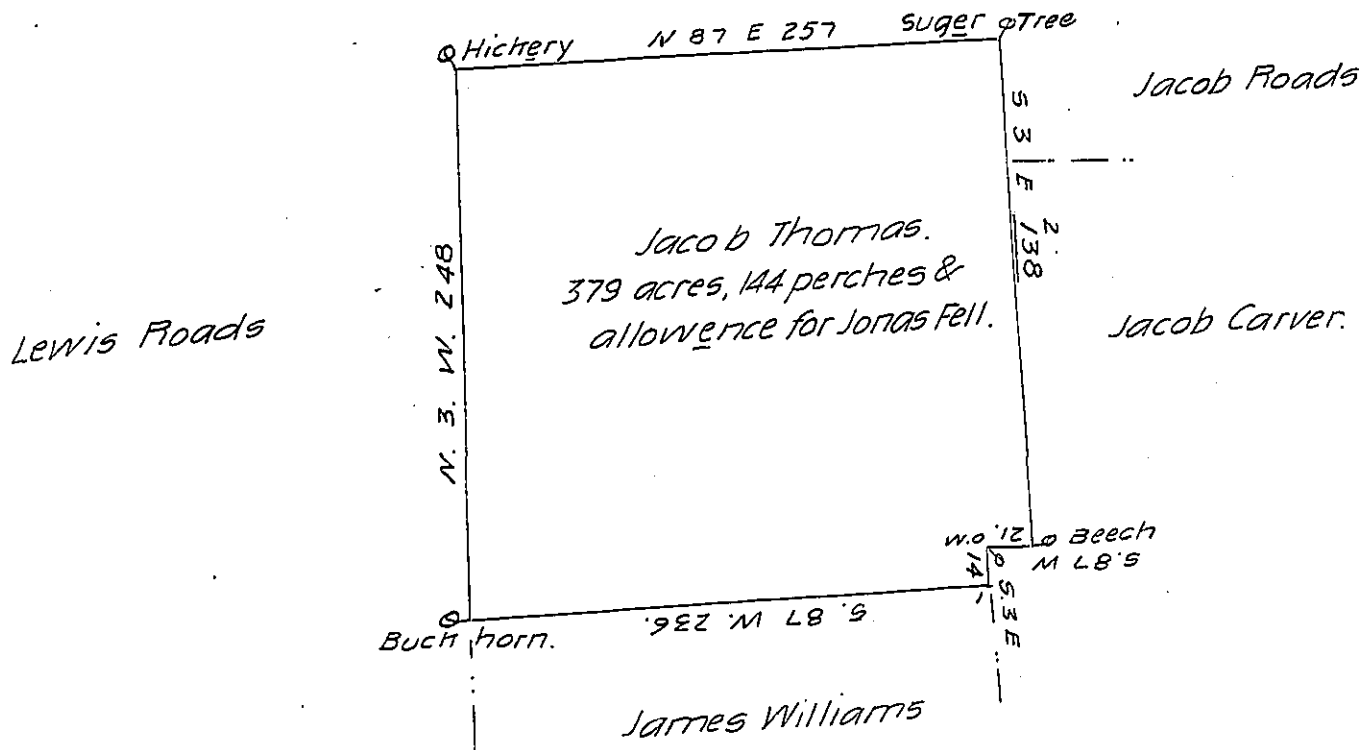


Samuel Watt.
