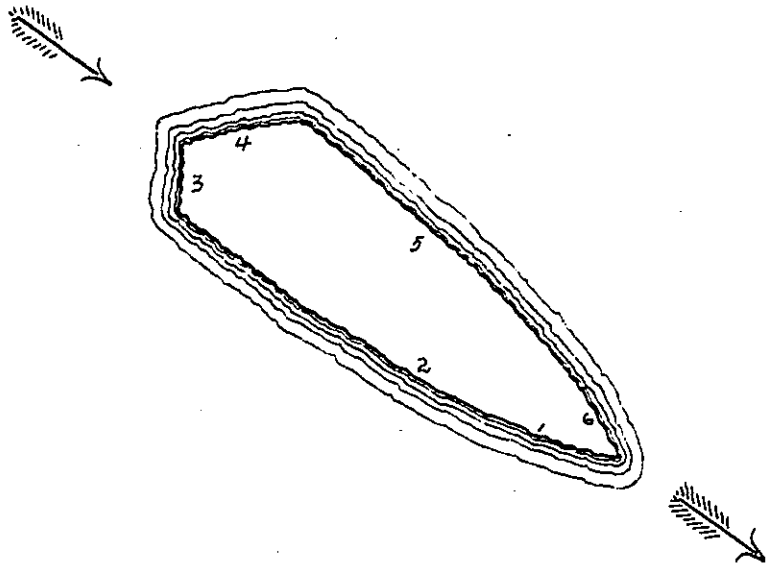


Courses & Dist<sup>s</sup> Beg.

Surveyed the 20<sup>th</sup> December 1820 for Christian Spayd the above described Island Situate in the River Susquehanna in Swatara Township Dauphin County, called "Rodsongs Wharf or Battery" about two miles above the mouth of Swatara Creek opposite the landing on Joseph Heisters lower farm, and about six hundred yards from the main land containing One Acre and one hundred & six perches Strict measure by his Warrant of the 19<sup>th</sup> December A. D. 1820.
