



The above is a Draught of a Survey made June 3<sup>d</sup> 1833, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Christopher Columbus Vennem, for ten Acres of land, Dated May 20<sup>th</sup> 1832 Containing ten Acres & 91 perches and Allowance of six pr. Cent Situate in Amwell Township Washington County on the waters of Ten mile Creek, being unimproved at the time of Survey, excepting a small strip on the side next Fetherling.
