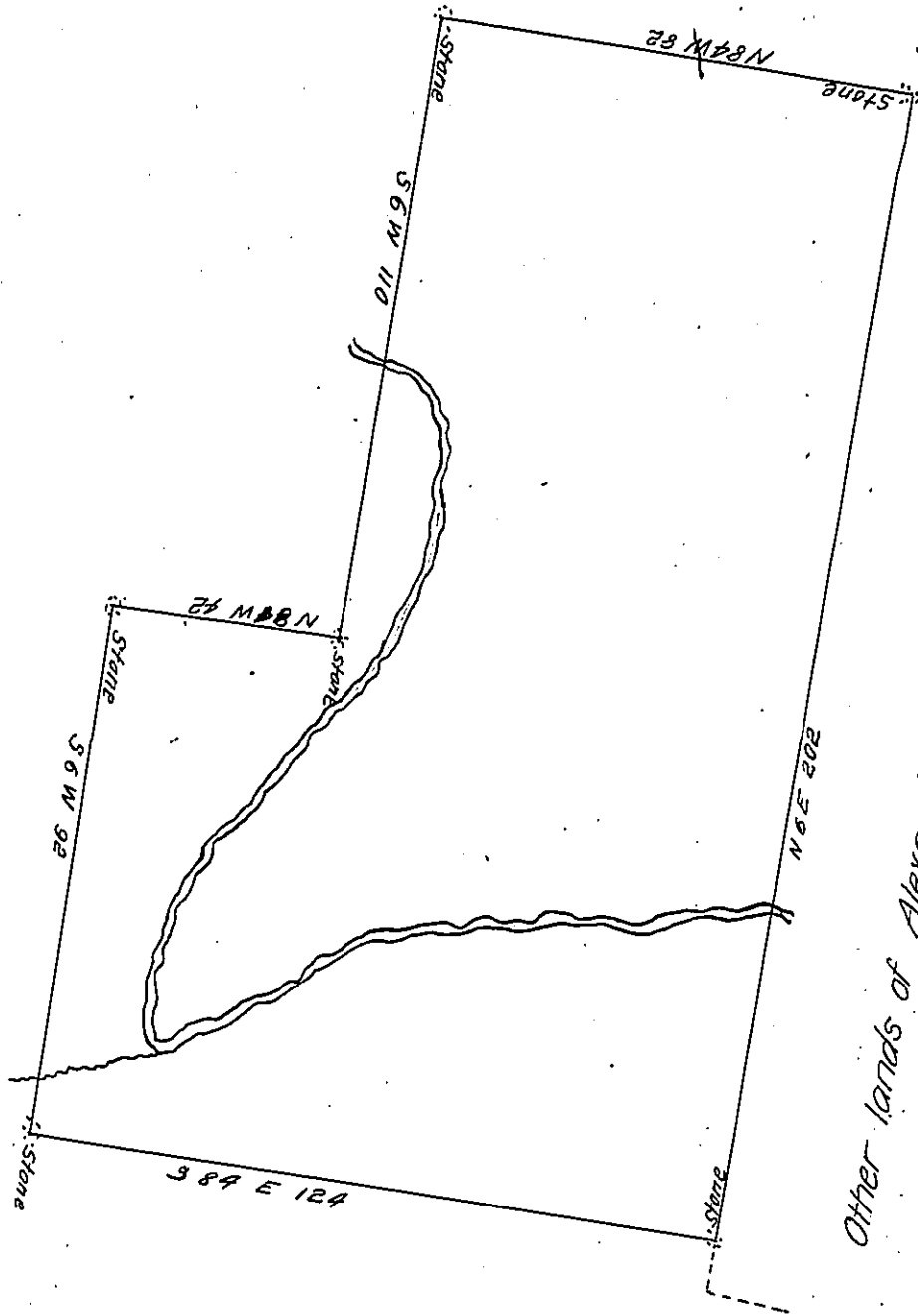

The above Tract of land was Originally Surveyed on the 24th day of October 1775 by George Palmer Esquire deputy Surveyor, and Resurveyed the 8th day of February 1816. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 2nd day of March 1775 to Alexander Van Gordon & Ludwick Hover, Situate on both Sides of Deckers Creek Delaware Township late Northampton now Pike County Containing one hundred and Twenty Acres & Sixty Seven perches and allowance of Six P. G. for Roads &c.^a
