



The above is a resurvey of part of a Tract of land called "Mount Conner" situate in (North) Union Township Fayette County, on Redstone Creek, originally surveyed July 10, 1770, for Cornelius Conner, in right of George Pearse, on application N<sup>o</sup>. 1057 dated April 3, 1769. Resurvey made Dec. 28, 1850.

The said Tract having been divided into two parts a Patent was granted for the Western part (154<sup>A</sup> 3<sup>R</sup> 13<sup>P</sup> & allce. to Gabriel D. Evans in 1824.

The title for the residue, as above, having by sundry conveyances become vested in John Vance the above survey is made and returned at his instance who now asks that a Patent issue to him therefor.
