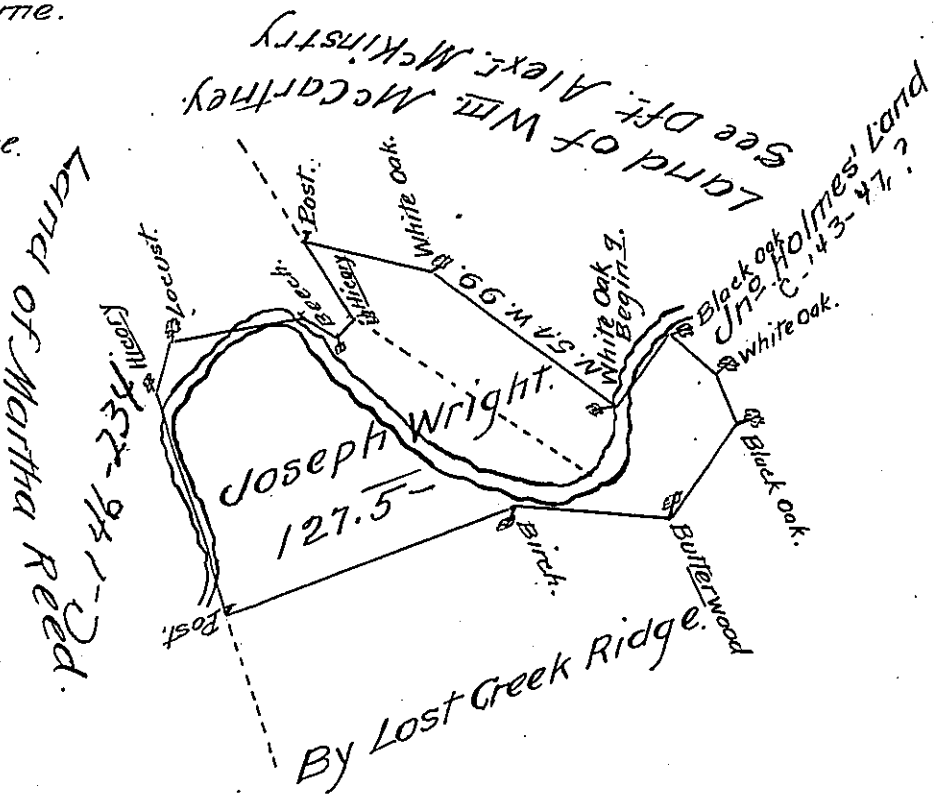

The Draught of a Tract of Land called Kingwood

for Roads. Survey'd the 20<sup>th</sup>. day of September Anno Dom. 1770  
In Pursuance of an Order of Survey to Joseph Wright Bearing  
date at Philad<sup>a</sup>. the 4<sup>th</sup>. day of August Anno Dom. 1767 No.  
4263 and agreeable to the Determination of the Board of Prop-  
erty of the 1<sup>st</sup>. May 1770 Joseph Wright v- W<sup>m</sup>. McCartney.
