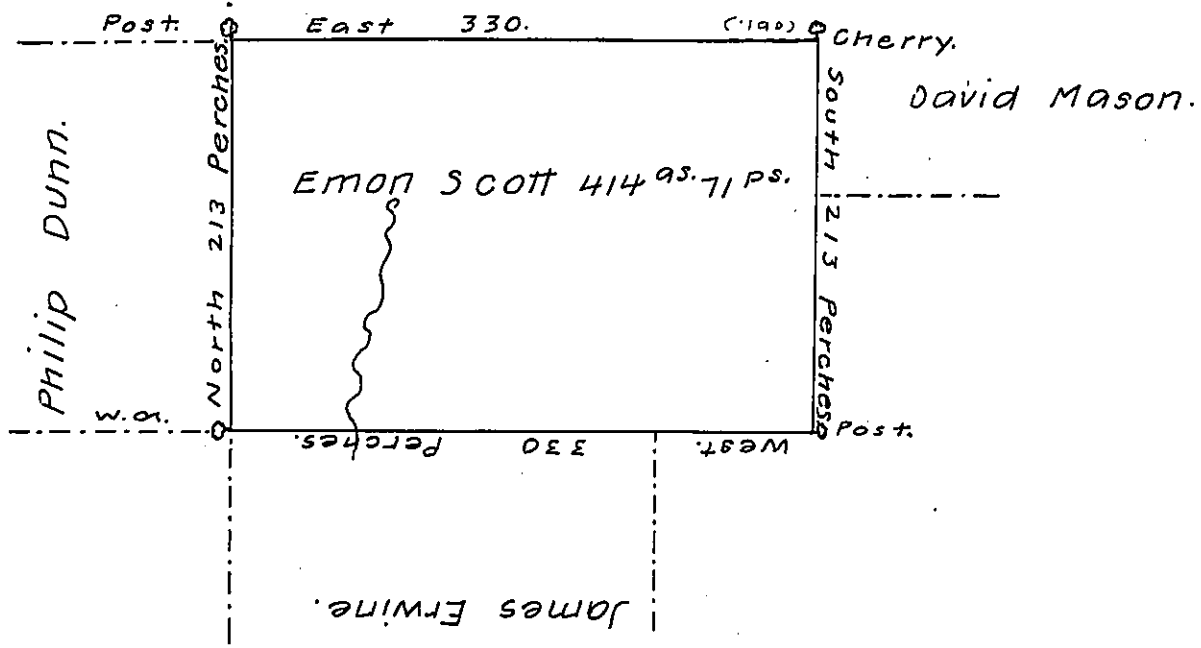

In Pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acres dated the 10th day of April 1793 granted to Emon Scott was surveyed on the first day of July A.D. 1818 The above described tract of land containing 414 acres 71 perches and allowance of six per cent for roads, &c. situated in Venango township, Crawford county, and at the time of making the same, H. Dunn was residing thereon, and there appeared to be upwards of 30 acres of the land cleared, fenced and in a state of cultivation, ~~and that the same was divided as above stated, between Joseph Clark and~~
