



Situate in Monaghan Township in the County of York. Containing 4<sup>as</sup> & 104 p<sup>s</sup> and allowance &c. Being part of a larger Tract of 478<sup>as</sup> and allowance &c., which was Originally Surveyed by George Stevenson late D.S. on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1751 for Richard Peters. In pursuance of three warrants Granted to Henry Swangy bearing date the 8<sup>th</sup> day of September A.D. 1741. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of July A.D. 1811 and at the request of Peter Tripner the present owner the same is returned for Confirmation the 26<sup>th</sup> day August A.D. 1811.
