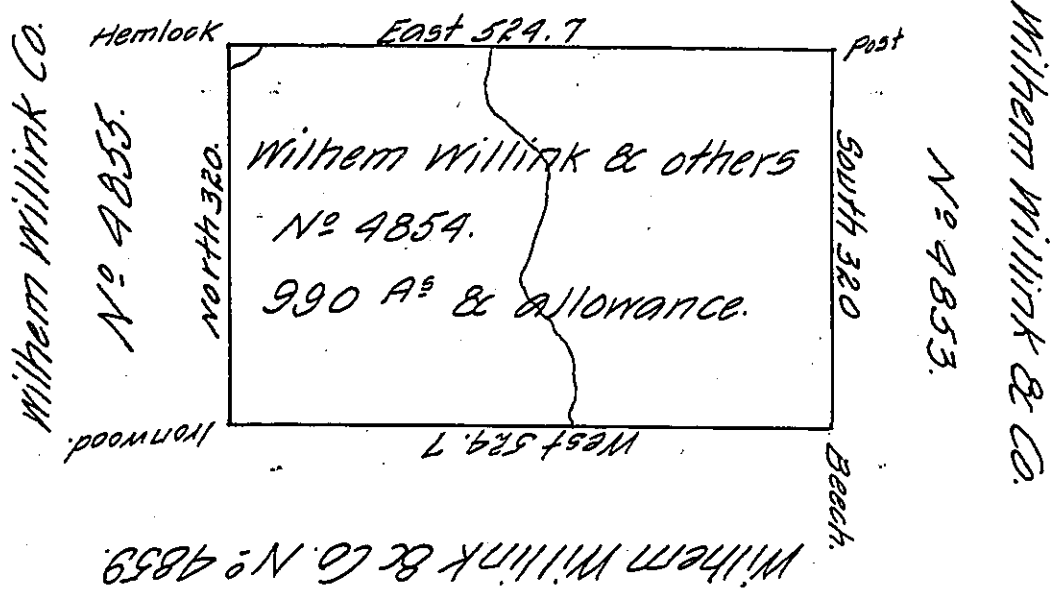


Wilhem Willink & others N^o 4849.



Situate in the fork of big Tobys Creek in the West side of District N^o 4 in Last purchase Containing Nine Hundred & Ninety Acres & the usual allowance of Six pr. Ct. for Roads &c. Surveyed the eighteenth day of ~~February~~^{July} 1794. By Warrant to Wilhem Willink, Nicholaas Van Staphorst Pieter Stadnitski Christiaan Van Eeghen Hendrick Vollen Hoven & Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam N^o 4854. Dated the third day of February 1794 for 900 Acres.
