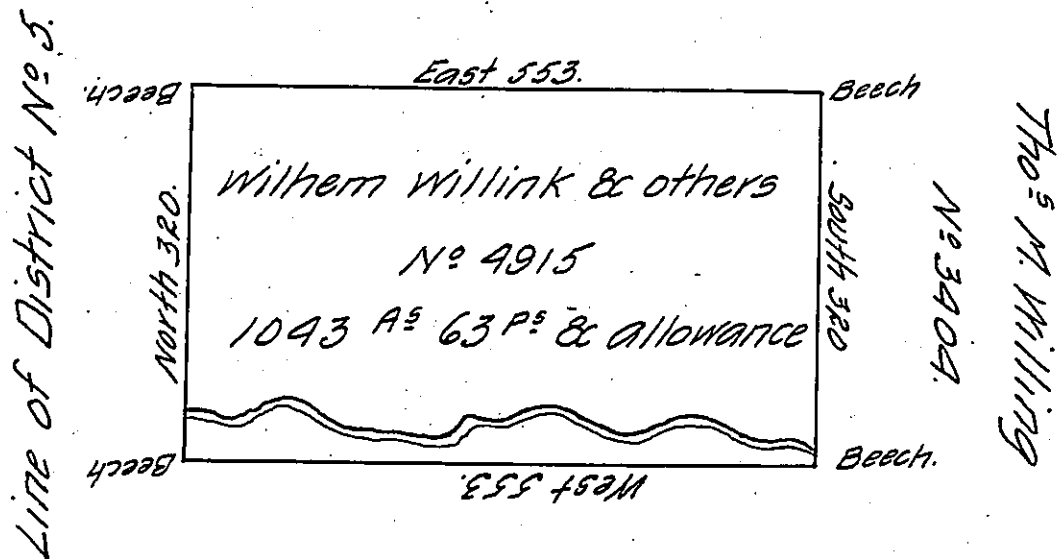


Wilhem Willink & others N^o 4914.



Wilhem Willink & others N^o 4916

Situate on the Kinzua^l Creek where it crosses the lin^e of District N^o 5 in the last purchase District N^o 4. Containing One Thousand & Forty three Acres Sixty three perches & the usual allowance of Six pr. Ct. for Roads &c. Surveyed the Twenty Eighth day of July 1794. By Warrant to Wilhem Willink Nicholaas Van Staphorst Pieter Stadnitski Christiaan Van Eeghen Hendrick Vollenhoven & Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam N^o 4915. Dated the third day of February 1794 for 900 Acres.
