Containing One Thousand & Forty three Acres Sixty three perches & the usual allowance &c. Surveyed the Twenty Ninth day of July 1794. By Warrant to Wilhem Willink Nicholaas Van Staphorst Pieter Stadnitski Christiaan Van Eeghen Hendrick Kollenthoven & Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam N<sup>o</sup> 4909. Dated the third day of February 1794 for 900 Acres.
