By Warrant to Wilhem Willink Nicholaas Van Staphorst Pieter Stadnitski Christiaan Van Eeghen Hendrick Vollenhoven & Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam N<sup>o</sup> 4872. Dated the third day of February 1794.
