



Draft of a small tract of land containing 5^{as} & 81 perches and allowance of Six per cent for roads &c. Situate in Saltlick Township Fayette County. Surveyed the 12 day of Sept. A.D. 1872 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Samuel Shaffer for 4 acres of land dated the 24 day of Feb. A.D. 1872. The above is a part of a tract Originally Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Godfrey Willey dated the 4 day of Feb. A.D. 1794, a part of which I surveyed & returned last Oct in pursuance of a Warrant granted to David A. Witt. dated the 16 day of Sept. 1871 and there still remains a small piece of the same unpatented as marked on the above draft, which is in the Occupancy of Jacob Imel, and on which there is erected a frame School House.
