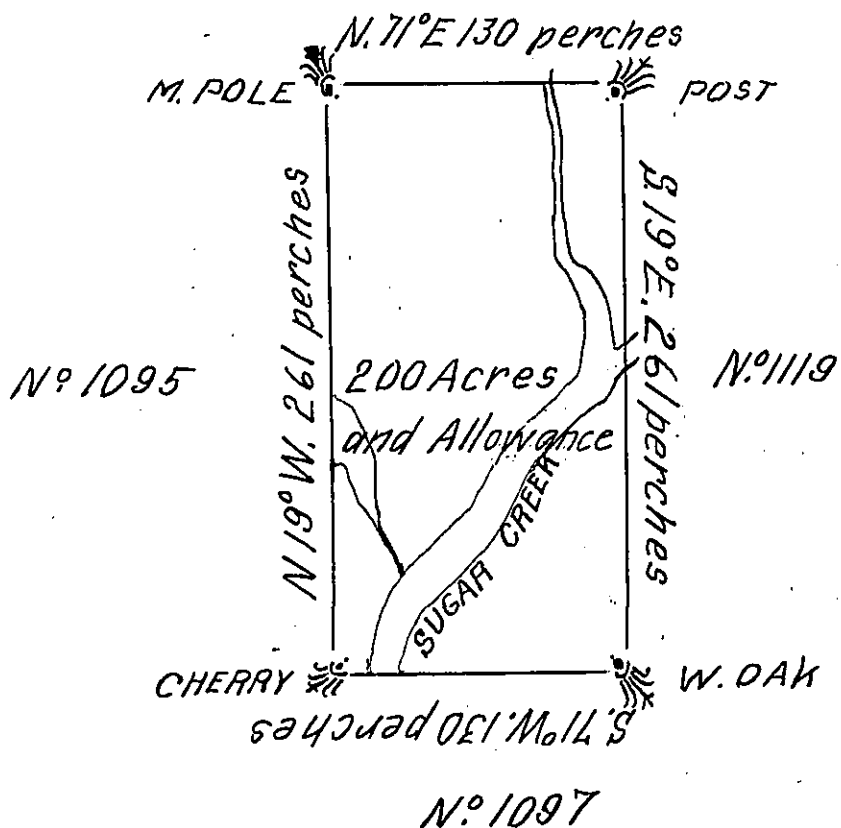

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day of February, 1785, intitled, 'An Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands, promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth,' and by order of the Surveyor-General with the approbation of the Honourable the Executive Council, I have surveyed on the fifth Day of November, 1785 the above described Tract of Two hundred Acres of Land, and Allowance of Six per Cent. for Roads &c. N^o 1096 situate in District N^o 6 on the West Side of Allegheny River in the County of Westmoreland
