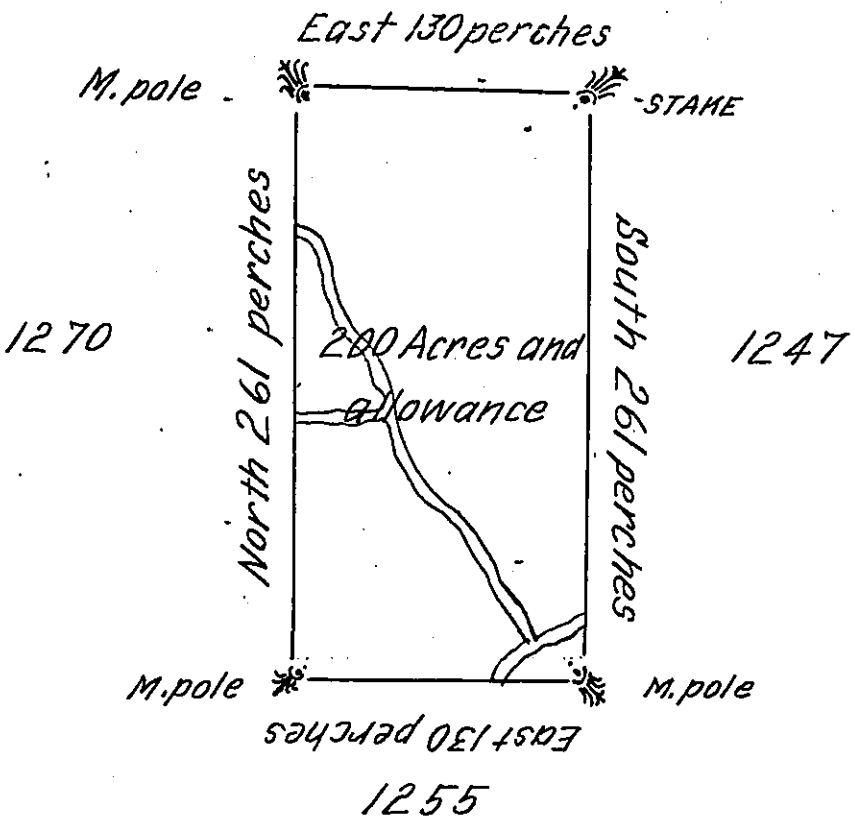

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth day of February 1785, intitled, 'An Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation-Lands promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth,' and by Order of the Surveyor-General, with the approbation of the Honourable the Executive-Council I have surveyed, on the Twenty eighth Day of November, 1785, the above described Tract of Two hundred Acres of Land and Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads, & No. 1246 situate in District No. 6, on the West Side of the Allegheny River in the County of Westmoreland.
