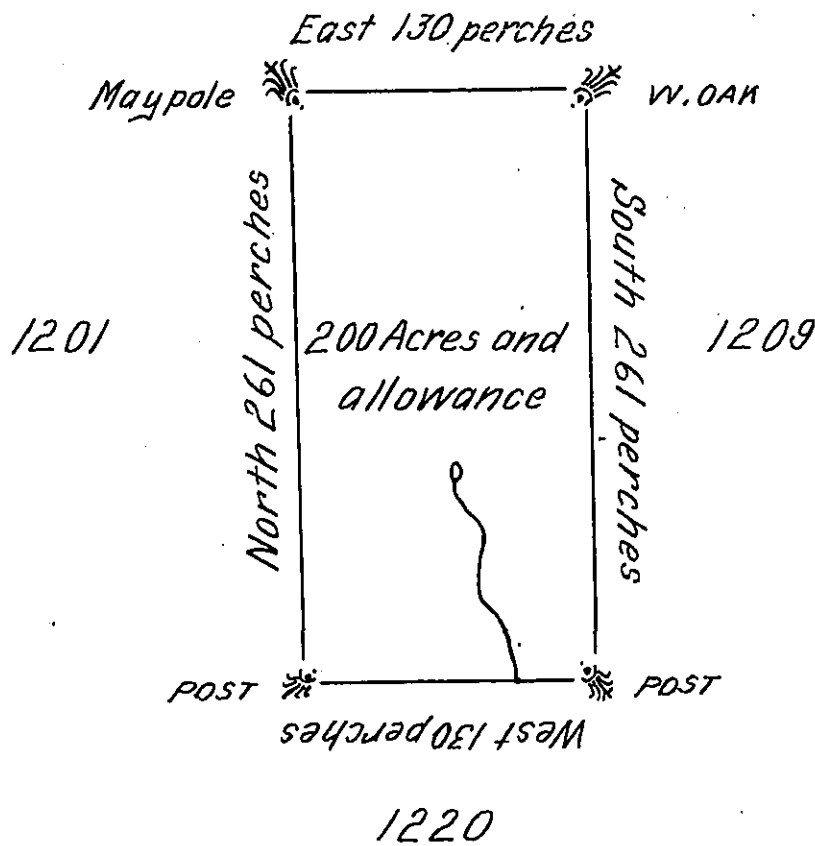

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day of February 1785, intitled, 'An Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation-Lands promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth,' and by Order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honourable the Executive-Council, I have surveyed, on the twenty first day of November 1785, the above described Tract of Two hundred Acres of Land and Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads, &c N<sup>o</sup> 1200 situate in District N<sup>o</sup> 6, on the West Side of the Allegheny River, in the County of Westmoreland.
