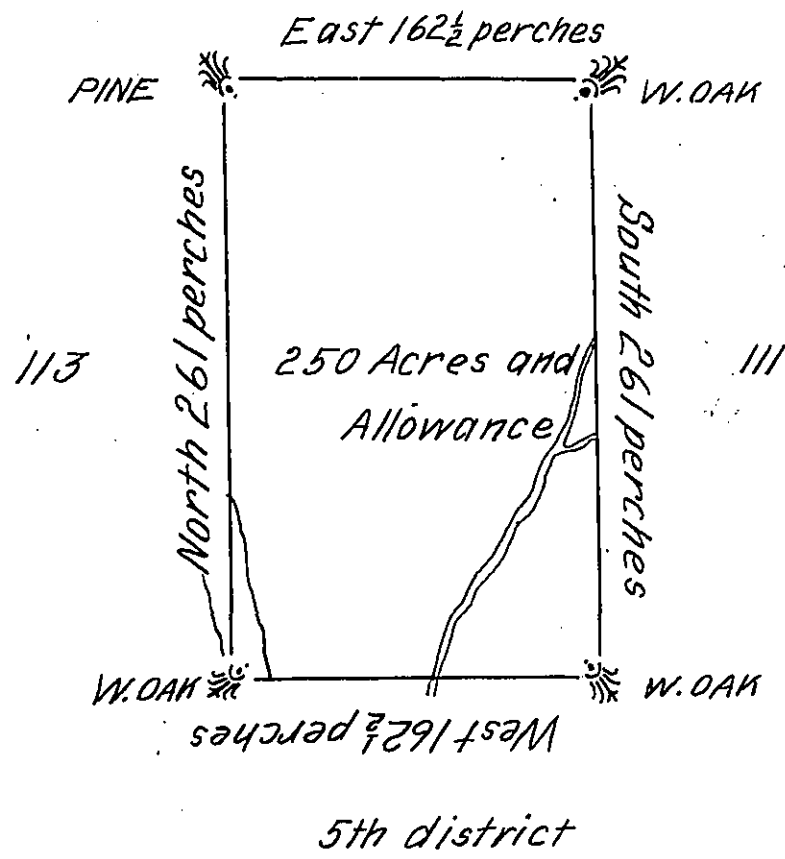


Donation-Land, in District No 6

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day of February 1785 intituled, 'An Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth,' and by order of the Surveyor General, with the approbation of the Honourable the Executive Council, I have surveyed, on the fifth Day of December, 1785, the above described Tract of Two hundred and fifty Acres of Land, and Allowance of Six per Cent. for Roads &c. No 112, situate in District No 6, on the West Side of the Allegheny River in the County of Westmoreland.
