



By virtue of a warrant dated the 12th day of March AD. 1819 surveyed the 14 & 15th June 1836 to Andrew Storm Administrator of the Estate of John Storm, deceased, and in trust for the heirs of the said dec^d the above described tract of land, situate in Hamilton township (formerly Northampton now) Monroe County, containing three acres one hundred and fifty-four perches and the allowance of six per cent &c.
