



By virtue of a warrant dated the 16th day of May 1796 surveyed the 14 & 15 June 1836. to Andrew Storm Administrator of the estate of John Storm deceased and in trust for the heirs of the said decd the above described tract of land, situate in Hamilton township, formerly Northampton now, Monroe County containing one acre and one hundred perches, and the allowance &c.
