
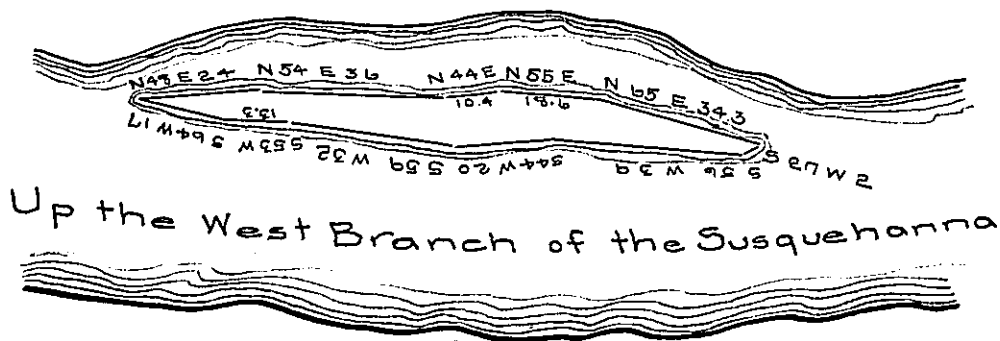


Black Hole Bottom

Situate in Clinton township Lycoming County in the West Branch of the river Susquehanna about one mile below Muncy Dam - Surveyed to Christian Seager on the 10th day of November 1842 containing three acres and thirty six perches strict measure, surveyed in pursuance of his warrant bearing date the first day of November 1842.
