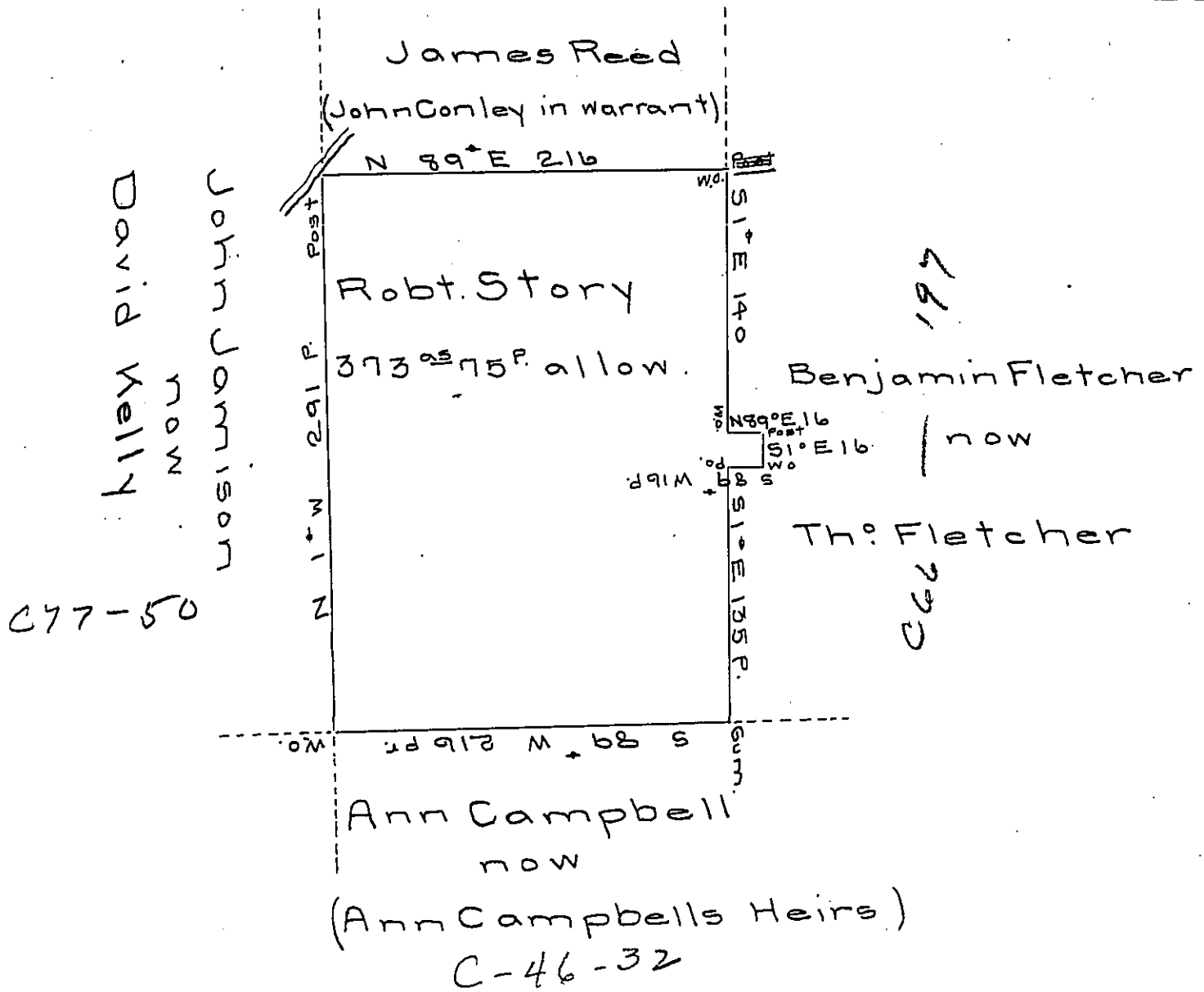

Surveyed to Robert Story the 22^d day of Nov. 1810 by virtue of his actual settlement & contain^g 373^{ac} 75^p per. & allowance, situate in Parker tp. Butler County on the waters of Bear creek, executed a warrant on the above ground dated nineteenth day of January 1813 calling for 350^{ac} granted to Robt Story, executed 19th May 1813.
