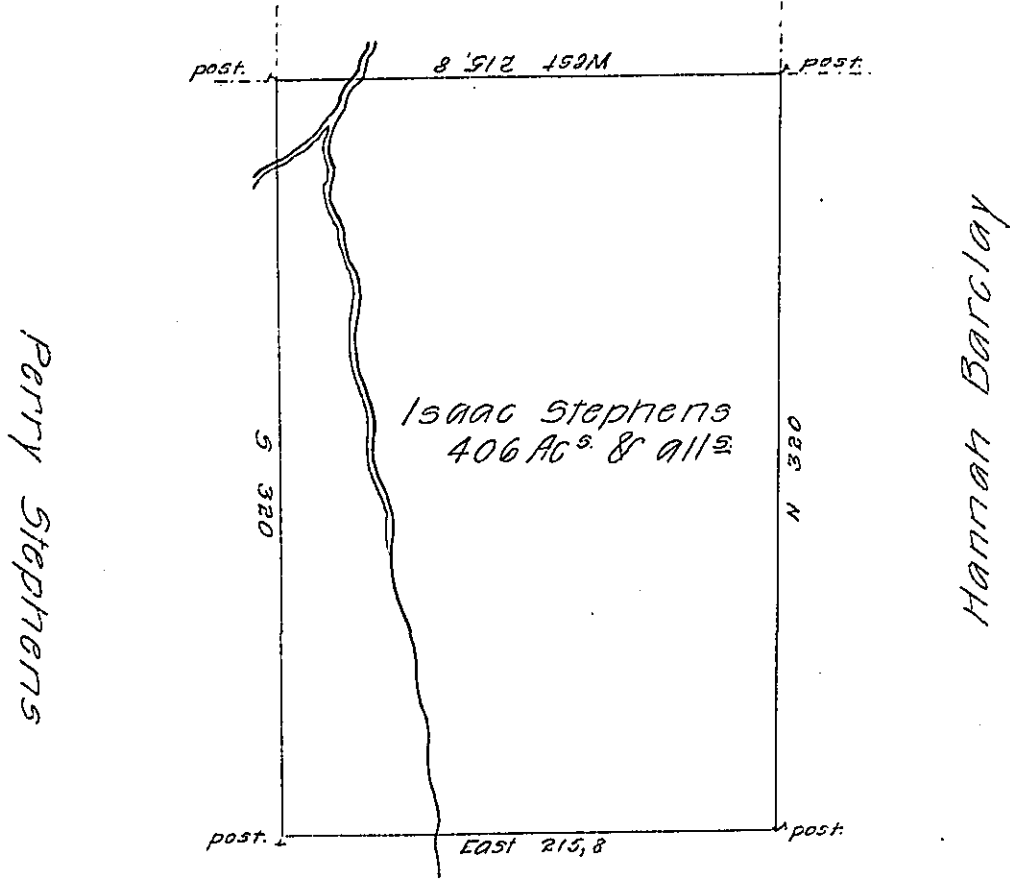


Christopher Marshal.
