pursuance of a warrant for 50^a Granted to Valentine Shade-
ker, bearing date the 11th day of June Anno Domini 1750 Re-
surveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land
by William Kersey late D.S. on the 19th day of the 6th m^o 1783
And now after having calculated examined & corrected the
same I am desired by the present owner John Kehler to
make return of the draught the 31st day of October Anno Domi-
ni 1809.
