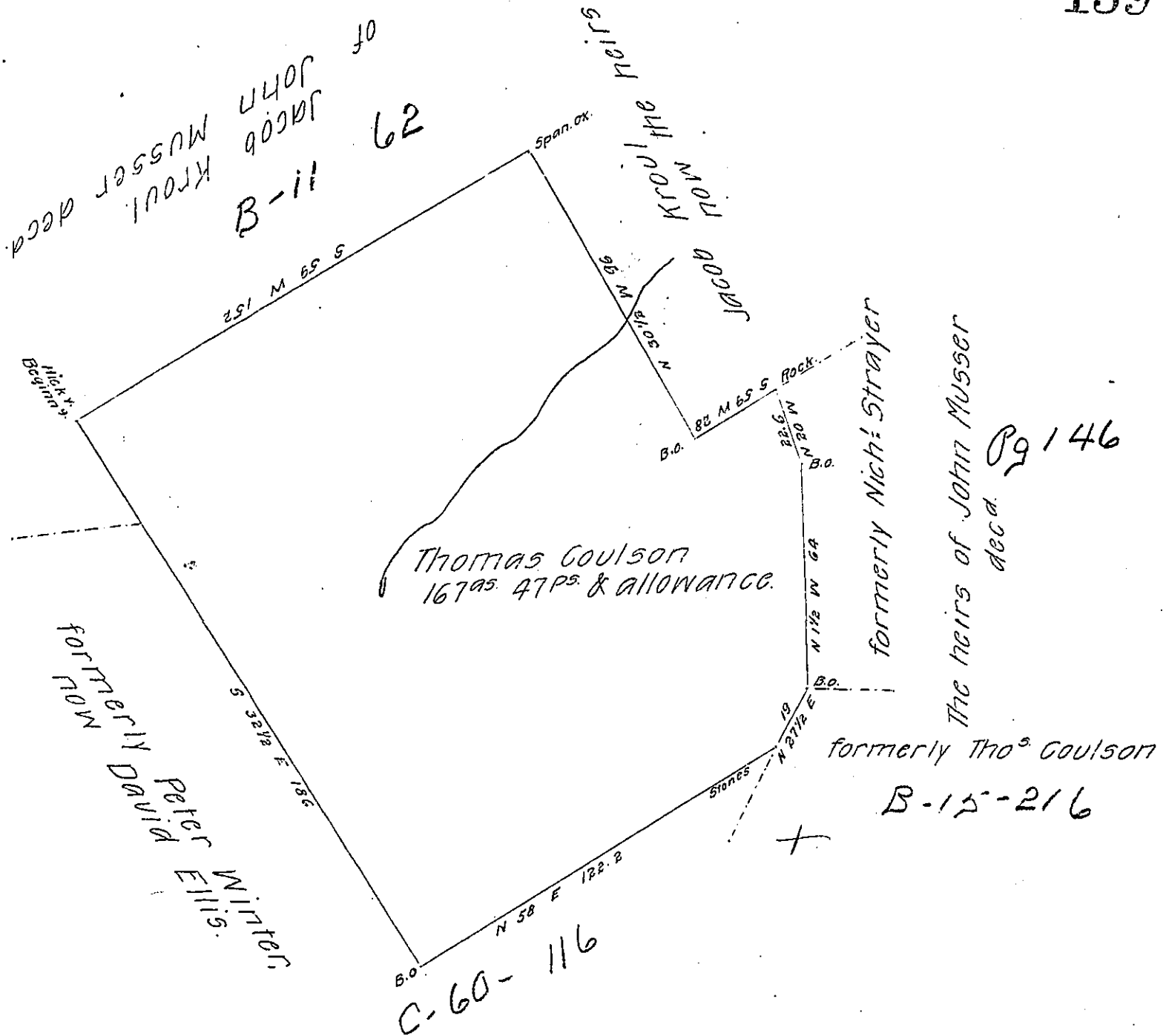

Situate in Chanceford township York County & containing as above set forth 167^{as} 47^{ps} & allowance of land, originally surveyed in part, by George Stevenson late D.S. on the first day of March 1754 in pursuance of a warrant bearing date the 18th of September 1749, * which survey was afterwards, on the 12th day of the 1st mo. 1769 Completed By William Matthews late D.S. in pursuance of an order of the Board of Property dated the 24th of April 1769. Resurveyed on the 17th day of May A.D. 1811, and now at the request of the Heirs of John Musser deceased who are the present owners it is returned for Confirmation the twenty eighth day of May Anno Domini 1811.
