



One Bradleys claim

In Pursuance of a Warrant bearing date December 13<sup>th</sup> 1786, Granted William Perry and Robert Worthington for 300 Acres. Surveyed on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of November 1787, unto Joseph Service in right of Robert Worthington the above discribed part of a tract Situate in Mountpleasant Township in the County of Westmoreland Containing one hundred and fifty one 1/2 Acres and allowance of six Pr Cent for roads &c.

 Surveyor General.

N.B. Previous to this draught I coppied the original survey and both halves and give into the hands of the person owning the other half, but am not certain of their reaching the office yet. and at the request of Service (being Urgent for his Patent) have sent the above being his half in rt of Worthington as they Wish to Patent separate.
