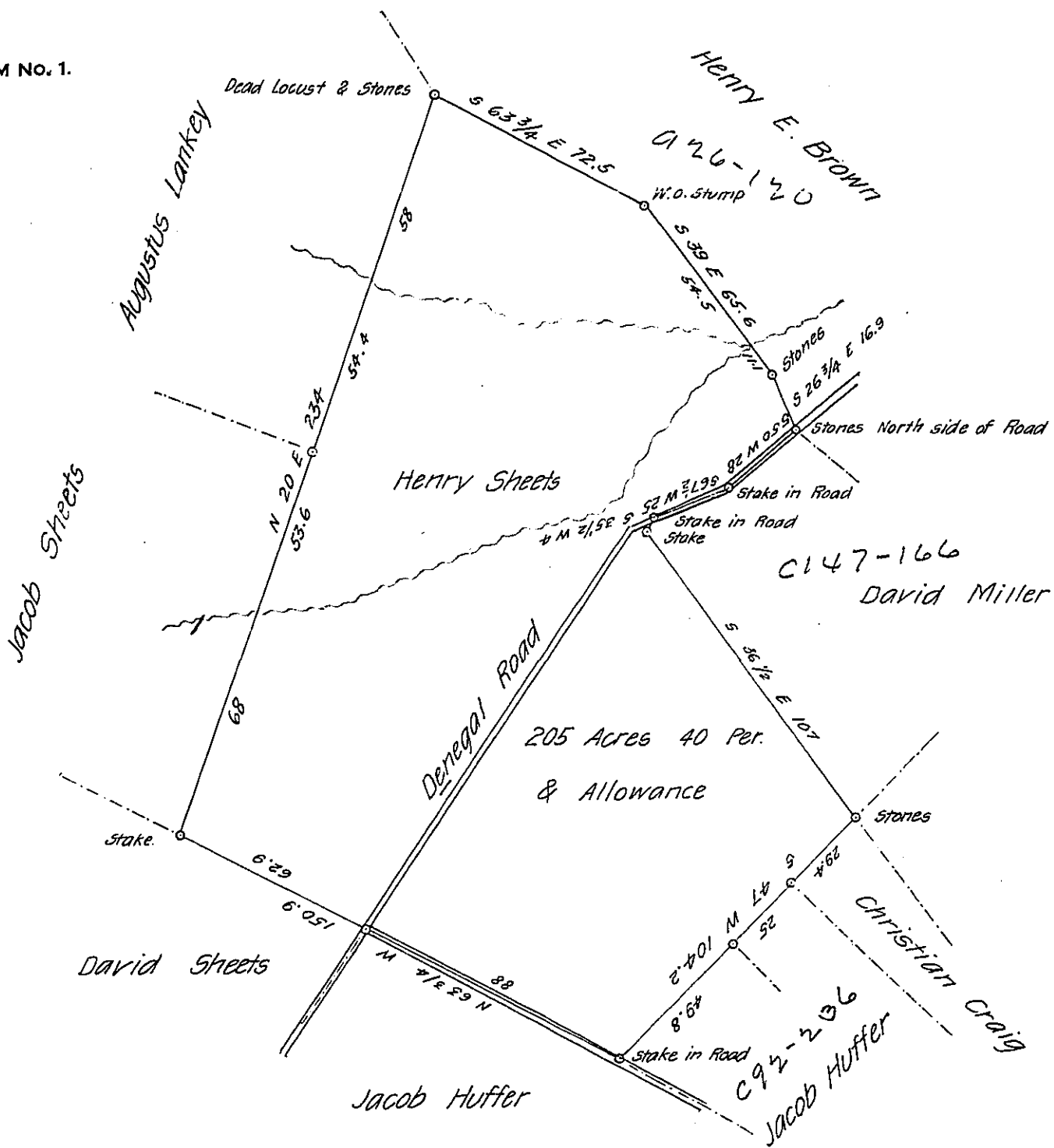


FORM No. 1.
