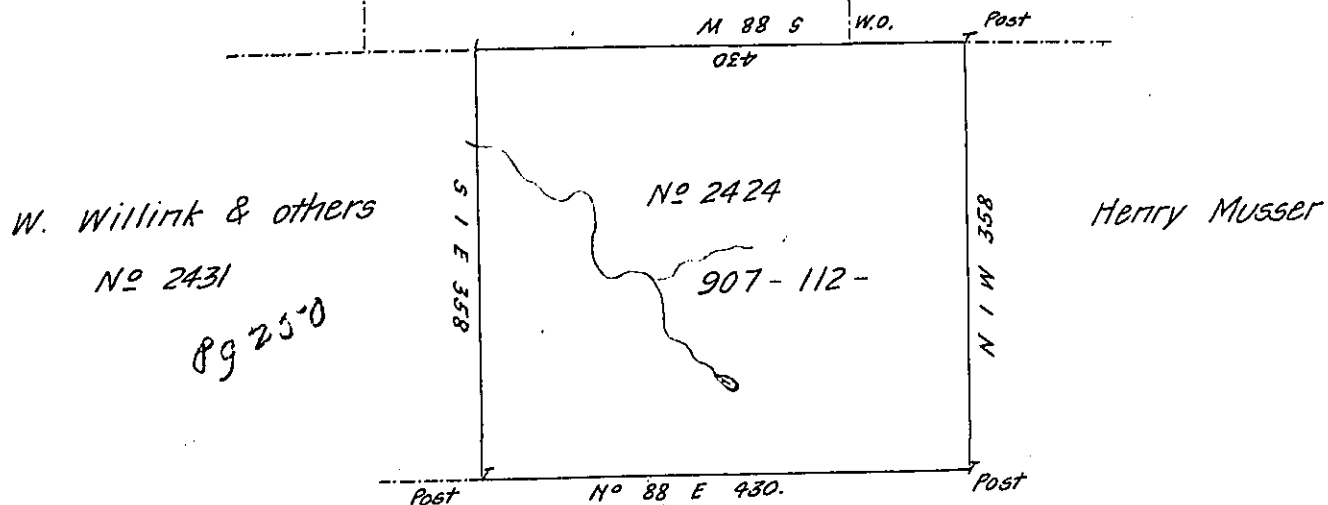

By Virtue of a warrant dated the 12th December 1792 No 2424 there was surveyed the 26th August 1794 by Wm P. Brady (the former Deputy Surveyor) to Wilhem Willink Nicholas Van Staphorst Christian Van Eeghen Hendrick Vollenhoven & Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck the above described Tract of Nine hundred & seven ^{112 perches} acres and Allowance Situate on the Waters of Stump Creek in District No 5 in the late purchase in the County of Lycoming—a copy of which remains in my office.
