



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property - dated the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3^d day of July following on a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a general Plan of said Town Number Seventy One Containing in Breadth North and South on Broadway Fifty seven Feet six Inches and in Length East and West Two hundred and Thirty feet. Bounded Westward by Broad Way aforesaid Southward by Lot Number Seventy two, Eastward by River Alley, and Northward by Lot Number Seventy, Returned into the Secretary's office the 9th day of January 1775 for Michael Troy Esq^{rs} by Warrant dated the 4th day of the same month.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February 1833, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this thirteenth day of March 1907
